Consideration and adoption of 2009/12 Draft Management Plan, which incorporates Special Rate Variation Application

Moree Plains Shire Council has opted to commence its meeting scheduled for this Thursday, 18 June 2009 at the earlier time of 10am.

Included on the agenda for the meeting is the final consideration and adoption of the 2009/12 Draft Management Plan, which incorporates Council's application for a Special Rate Variation to be applied for the 2009/10 rating year.

Acting General Manager, Murray Erbs said "The reason for the earlier start is to allow for adequate time to fully consider public submissions made in relation to the 2009/12 Draft Management Plan, and Special Rate Variation"

Council has undertaken an extensive community consultation program in relation to both the application for a Special Rate Variation and the Management Plan.

Mr Erbs said "We received numerous submissions and a petition during the consultation period and these will be considered as part of the adoption process at Thursday's meeting."

As normal a Public Forum will take place at the beginning of the meeting and members of the public are invited to speak on any matters listed on the agenda.
