

AS 4308:2008 DRUG CLASSES

The Australian Standard states that you are not permitted to have the following drugs in your system while at work:

- 1. Methamphetamines
- 2. Cocaine
- 3. Marijuana
- 4. Morphine
- 5. Benzodiazepines

The following table gives some information about the different drug classes, their effects and how long they stay in your system.
