## **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. That the Moree Plains Shire Council endorse the application for a grant under the Stronger Country Communities Fund Round Three, Stage 2 Banquet Hall, for the establishment of Multi-Purpose Theatre/Cinema in the Moree Memorial Hall Civic Precinct. That the application is subject to the terms and conditions below;**
  - a) The Multi-Purpose Theatre/Cinema Facility will be operated at arm's length from Council and without any extra financial cost to Council.**
  - b) That a 355 Committee be established to be responsible for all costs and operations of the Multi-Purpose Theatre/Cinema Facility established under the Stronger Country Communities Fund Round Three grant. The other areas of the complex do not come under the care and control of the 355 Committee and remain under Council control.**
  - c) The 355 Committee to be responsible for the day to day operation of the facility. This includes all payment of wages, salary, electricity, cleaning and all other cost associated with the day to day running of the operation. The repair and maintenance, replacement and depreciation cost of all assets acquired under the grant be the responsibility of the 355 Committee.**
  - d) In the event that some later date the continued operation of the facility is not financially viable the 355 Committee will be responsible for the closing down of the facility, the sale and removal of all equipment installed under the Stronger Country Communities Fund Round Three grant that the Council deems as surplus to requirements at the time.**
  - e) The Stronger Country Communities Fund Round Three grant in this application is bases on the costing tabled at the Ordinary Council Meeting for the upgrade of the Stage 2 Banquet Hall and is attached. Being \$434,000 less the co-funding contribution amount being \$108,500 that is 25% of the total cost. Reducing the Stronger Country Communities Fund Round Three grant application to \$325,500.**

The repair and maintenance, replacement and depreciation cost of all assets acquired under the grant be the responsibility of the 355 committee.

In the advent that at some later date the continued operation of the facility is not financially viable the 355 committee will be responsible for the closing down of the facility, the sale and removal of all equipment installed under the grant that the Council deems as surplus to requirments at that time.

The grant in this application is based on the costing tabled at the Council meeting, for the upgrade of the Stage 2 Banquet Hall and is attached. Being \$434,000.00 less the Co-Funding contribution amount being \$108,500.00, that is 25% of the total cost. Reducing the grant application to \$325,500.00.
