

Moree Civic Precinct Redevelopment Project Reference Group Expressions of Interest

Moree Plains Shire Council is calling for Expressions of Interest from residents with a broad background in the arts and cultural event management and/or knowledge of the range of key infrastructure elements that are required for an effective multi-use arts and culture facility to join the Moree Civic Precinct Redevelopment Project Reference Group (Reference Group) as one of three Community Representatives.

The aim of the Reference Group is provide input, advice and expertise about the range of key arts and culture infrastructure elements that are required for an effective multi-use facility to the Project Team. Preference will be given to community members with the broadest range of relevant experience.

The focus of the Moree Civic Precinct Redevelopment Project is upgrades to bring the Civic Precinct into compliance with current National Construction Code (building) requirements such as for power, lighting, communications, heating, cooling, fire safety, and access including for people with disabilities. In addition, other key safety elements including the mezzanine, stage and rigging will be addressed as well as the potential provision for rooftop solar. Future proofing the facility will be given special consideration to ensure that the potential range of future uses are provided for, or are able to be provided for in future redevelopment stages.

Although the Moree Civic Precinct Redevelopment Project Reference Group will have no decision-making authority it will have an essential role in advising on the redevelopment of the Moree Civic Precinct. Membership of the Group includes:

- Moree Plains Shire Heritage Advisor
- 2 Council Officers
- Head Contractor

Applicants must be a resident residing within the local government area of Moree Plains Shire.
