

Which Bin? Competition - Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. The promoter is Moree Plains Shire Council (ABN: 46 5667 905 82), 30 Heber St, Moree NSW 2400 (**'Promoter'**).
2. Information on prizes and how to enter the **Which bin? Competition** forms part of these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
3. By entering the Which Bin? Competition (**'competition'**), each entrant accepts these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
4. Entry to this competition is open to residents of the Moree Plains Shire with a domestic waste service. A property can only be registered in the competition once.
5. The competition commences Monday 28 October 2019 and concludes midnight Friday 29 November 2019 (**'the competition period'**). During the first week of the competition period, no weekly competition winner will be announced thus providing all residents with an equal opportunity to participate in the competition.
6. The aim of the competition is to encourage correct recycling practices, to reduce contamination rates in the kerbside, recycling and organics collection service as the prize is dependent on correctly sorting domestic waste. This competition is a Gratuitous Lottery for Government promotion not a trade lottery, based on the condition of having a waste service.
7. To enter the competition and be eligible to win the prize as a **'registered property address'**, a person must:
 - a. Download the MPSC Waste app from the App Store or Google Play.
 - b. Register property details in the **"Which Bin? Competition Registration"** using the MPSC Waste App form tab.
 - c. Agree to household recycled waste (yellow lid) and organic waste (green lid) bin content being inspected to confirm only correct materials are placed in the correct bin. Information regarding correct disposal can be found:
 - i. The "Bin Info" section of the MPSC Waste App,
 - ii. Council's website (<https://www.mpsc.nsw.gov.au/index.php/rubbish-and-recycling/kerbside-collection-services/wheelie-bins-red-yellow-and-green>); and
 - iii. Stamped on the top of the bin lid.
 - d. Only place the correct materials in the recycling (yellow) or organics (green lid) bin. Bins of a registered property address which are inspected and found to contain incorrect material (**'contamination'**) will be disqualified from the competition.

- e. Ensure, property bins are presented for collection before 6am on the scheduled collection day.
8. At the commencement of the second week of the competition period (and for each of the three weeks thereafter), registered property addresses will be selected randomly. The first selected registered property address will be subject to a kerbside bin content inspection to determine whether the correct material has been placed in the correct bins (recycling or organic bin) according to the collection week schedule. If contamination is detected in the bin at that registered property address, inspections at other randomly selected registered property addresses will be undertaken until an uncontaminated bin is found. The person who registered the property address of the first uncontaminated bin will be declared the winner of the competition for that week (**'weekly competition winner'**).
9. A prize of 1 x \$250 Love Local Gift Card will be awarded to each weekly competition winner.
10. The total prize pool is \$1,000.
11. The winner for the week will be announced Friday each week during the competition period on Council's Facebook page.
12. The judges' decision is final and binding. As such, no correspondence will be entered into. If any entrant of a registered property address engages in conduct questioning the judges' decision, such person will be permanently disqualified from the competition.
13. If for any reason a winner does not take the prize or an element of the prize by the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize or that element of the prize will be forfeited. All prize winners agree to the use of their name for publicity and competition purposes, without compensation.
14. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with entering the competition or accepting or using a prize(s) except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. The Promoter does not encourage participants to decontaminate their bins themselves, if they do not have absolute knowledge of the bin's contents.
15. The Promoter, their associated agencies and companies associated with this competition take no responsibility for any delay in delivery, damage to or loss in transit of the prize.
16. Each entrant's personal information (**'information'**) is collected to enable the Promoter to administer and promote the competition and the winners. The information of winners may be provided to third parties who are assisting the Promoter, including prize suppliers, deliverers and authorities that regulate competitions. Entrants who fail to provide all requested information, may be

determined by the Promoter, at its sole discretion to be ineligible to win a prize. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

17. The Promoter assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, corruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of, entries. The Promoter is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer networks and systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any e-mail or entry to be received by the Promoter on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site, or any combination of them, including any injury or damage to any entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in this competition.
18. The laws of New South Wales govern Moree Plains Shire Council competitions.
19. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions of Entry, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardize the fair and proper conduct of the competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
20. If for any reason the competition is not capable of running as planned (including any causes beyond the control of the Promoter), the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
