



## UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI) CODE

### **Unique Student Identifier (USI) as a Government Requirement.**

As of the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015 the government requires all citizens to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI) in order to access any recognised training.

No training organisation is able to issue qualifications or certificates for recognised training without the individual providing this number.

In order to attend training you must personally follow these links to get a USI:

To complete you will require a form of identification listed which can be for example a drivers licence or Medicare card.

You must retain your USI (eg in your wallet) as you will need it each time you attend recognised training.
